

How to find us



From the start of your journey to Nosara, your adventurous vacation can begin. The road from San José to Nosara is varied and beautiful. The drive takes approximately 5 hours and we recommend that you travel with a 4x4 vehicle.

The Road to Nosara

From San José, take the Panamericana highway heading north towards Liberia. The paved road takes you through the Valle Central towards the Guanacaste peninsula, offering breathtaking views of mountains and valleys throughout the trip. As you travel west, the weather will begin to change as the temperatures rise. After about 2 and a half hours (Shell Gasstation) turn left towards the new bridge to get to the Tempisque River that meets the ocean. From there, it is about 28 kilometers to Nicoya, the largest city in the region. The distance

from San José to Nicoya is 298 km. Pass through the Center of Nicoya, where you will see the oldest church in the country and from there take the road heading towards Samara. After 30km there will be a gas station on the left. 100mts. After the gas station, veer to the right, this is where the paved road ends and that will lead you to Nosara. After 25km (4km before Nosara) you will pass the "Café de Paris" another 200mts. more, following the same road, turn left just before the "Giardino Tropicale." There are signs that indicate the directions to "Casa Romántica."

By Bus

The bus company Alfaro departs every day at 6am from San José to Nosara. The bus stop is located at Calle 14, Avenida 5. The ticket costs 8.-\$ and the trip takes approximately 5½ hours, depending on traffic and road conditions. We recommend that you buy your tickets one day in advance.

By Plane

Sana and Nature Air departs every day to and from San José to Nosara.

The flight takes 45 minutes and the tickets cost between 70.- and 80.-\$.

Certain airline companies land in Liberia's international airport. From there you can rent a car as well.

The drive from Liberia to Nosara takes about 2½ hours. However, the majority of airline companies fly to San José.
